sexologist and author of *Dr. Sprinkle's Spectacular Sex* for 20 years the *Ethical Slut* widely known as the poly bible has dispelled myths and showed curious readers how to maintain a successful polyamorous lifestyle through open communication emotional honesty and safer sex practices the third edition of this timeless guide to the ethics of relationships communication and sex has been revised to include interviews with poly millennials young people who have grown up without the prejudices their elders encountered regarding gender orientation sexuality and relationships tributes to polyamory pioneers tools for conflict resolution and instructions on how to improve interpersonal dynamics new sidebars on topics such as asexuality sex workers lgbtq terminology and ways polys can connect and thrive the authors also include new content addressing nontraditional relationships beyond the polyamorous paradigm of more than two couples who don't live together couples who don't have sex with each other nonparallel arrangements couples with widely divergent sex styles power disparities and cross orientation relationships while utilizing nonbinary gender language and new terms that have come into common usage since the last edition

when a black indigenous or racialized individual or relationship works with a sex therapist a host of cultural circumstances can contribute to intimacy discord and sexual dysfunction this collection brings together clinicians and educators who share their approaches bridging sex therapy with a client's relationship to their racial cultural and ethnic identity this essential book aims to enhance therapists supervisory practices and clinical treatments when working with culturally diverse and marginalized populations fostering greater understanding and awareness innovative tools that integrate the impacts of acculturation minority status intersectionality and minority stress are discussed with case studies demonstrations and critical questions included this collection is a necessary read for anyone who is training to be or who is an established sex therapist marriage and family therapist relationship counselor or sexuality educator and consultant
